These worthy organizations provide a variety of goods and services to meet the needs of those in our immediate community, as well as surrounding towns. If visiting guests would like to contribute to this annual tradition, a list of suggested items for each organization is listed below. All donations should be wrapped in *plain white tissue paper*, labeled with the appropriate recipient/organization.

Apple Rehab -- Large piece puzzle, word search books, Chapstick, colored pencils, spray cologne, small picture frame, nail polish (standard colors), candy/chocolates, socks, hairbrush/comb, hand lotion, dusting powder, body wash and paperback books.

Friendship Center – Toiletries for teens and adults, coloring posters/books, puzzles, board games, Legos, men’s, and women’s clothing (sizes L-XXL), socks and gloves (especially large men’s and women’s), jump ropes, diapers, baby wipes, bath towels and wash cloths.
